- Picture books, mask and disinfectant were presented to :Ku Rar Rar Nar Mar Monestry (60 children 6 teachers) in Aung Theik Hti Road , Insein Township , Yangon , Myanmar.



We read aloud with a Japanese guide. Previously, children were sitting all over the floor, but due to the influence of Corona and the military coup, the children were taken over by their relatives and parents and evacuated.



Masks were also distributed in the neighborhood of the monastery.

In April 2022, 4000 second edition picture books were published in Dhaka, Bangladesh.

In June 2022, 500 second edition picture books were published in Yangon, Myanmar.
